

- Seamless execution of online assessments at scale



- Secure storage of evidence for post-exam review and audits


The scope excludes live human video proctoring unless explicitly enabled for specific assessments.

Supported Assessment Types



Environment

- Well-lit room with disturbance-free atmosphere and a plain background.
- Candidate must be alone and seated throughout the assessment

System Check

- Automated system check is mandatory before assessment start
- Failure to meet requirements may restrict exam access




PROCESS OF ACCESSING THE PLATFORM

Candidates can access the assessment platform using the official examination

Login Process:

- Open the platform URL in a supported browser
- Enter registered Username and Password
- **Click login to proceed to custom field** (entity can alter this field upon requirements. This is an optional feature can disable if not required)
- Click Login to proceed to the dashboard





Candidate Dashboard

Upon successful login, the candidate dashboard is displayed.

The dashboard allows candidates to:

- View assigned examinations
- Check exam date and time
- Read instructions and notifications
- Start the assessment when enabled




Starting an Exam

To begin the assessment, the candidate must:

- Click Start Test from the dashboard
- Allow required browser permissions (camera, microphone, location)
- Capture ID image and live profile image





Once all steps are completed successfully, the candidate is redirected to the System Check Page.





FOR IMAGE PROCTORED ASSESSMENTS



In the system check page, select the appropriate camera and microphone and allow the system to access both.




After granting camera and microphone access, the system will automatically check the internet connectivity speed and display the results. Then follow the Guidelines on Proctoring Gestures & Unfair Means During Exam and acknowledge the same.




Read the examination instructions carefully and acknowledge them to continue. After acknowledging the instructions, grant permission to access the web camera.




Once camera access is successfully enabled, the candidate will be redirected to the examination page.






FOR VIDEO PROCTORED ASSESSMENTS


On the System Check Page, the candidate must share the Entire Screen before initiating the system check.




Then allow access to the microphone and grant permission to share the screen as instructed. After granting the required permissions, the system will automatically check the internet connectivity speed and display the results.




In the photo verification section, capture a live photograph of the candidate. The captured live photograph will be verified against the registered image upon clicking the Verify button. Once verification is successful, the candidate will be allowed to start the examination.











Follow the Guidance on Proctoring Gestures & Unfair Means During the Exam and acknowledge the instructions.




Read the examination instructions carefully and acknowledge the same. After acknowledging the examination instructions, grant permission to access the web camera.




Once the entire screen is shared successfully, the candidate will be redirected to the examination page.






CANDIDATE EXAM WINDOW

The Candidate Exam Window is the primary interface through which candidates view questions, submit responses, and navigate the examination. It provides real-time visibility of exam status, remaining time, and proctoring indicators, ensuring a structured and compliant assessment experience.



Unfair Means indicators are triggered when the system detects face mismatch, multiple faces, face not present, permission revoked, object detection, screen focus loss, or voice detection, indicating possible deviation from proctoring rules.




EXAM SUBMISSION & CONFIRMATION

This step outlines the final submission process of the examination. Candidates are required to review their responses carefully and complete the mandatory verification steps before submitting the test.


Submission Process

Before submitting the assessment, ensure that all questions are attempted. Once completed, click on Submit Test to proceed. A confirmation prompt will be displayed. Review the message and click Yes, Submit Test to confirm submission.




Before final submission, the candidate must capture the ID image and live profile image again for end-of-exam verification.

Click Save and Next to complete the submission process.
